ASHP Foundation Announces the 2017 Advanced Pain Management Traineeship Participants *Twelve pharmacists complete intensive training to improve care of patients requiring pain management and palliative care.*

BETHESDA, MD (June 16, 2017) – Twelve pharmacists recently completed the ASHP Research and Education Foundation’s Advanced Pain Management Traineeship.

Properly managing chronic pain continues to be a top priority for healthcare professionals. This hands-on, five-month, tiered educational initiative combines distance and onsite experiential training with a post-traineeship requirement of applying and demonstrating newly obtained skills in their practice setting. Pharmacists will learn to develop comprehensive services for patients in pain and those with palliative care needs and serve as a valuable resource on healthcare teams.

“Pharmacists are increasingly being called upon to assist with chronic disease management,” said Chris Herndon, Pharm.D., traineeship faculty member and professor at the Southern Illinois University Edwardsville School of Pharmacy. “Specialty training allows the pharmacist to truly be the drug therapy expert in the respective field of training. The ASHP Foundation traineeships are not just the delivery of content, but the enhancement of clinical confidence. This separates the traineeships from standard course programs.”
