Steven A. Rubloff Appointed Chief Executive Officer of the ASHP Research and Education Foundation

BETHESDA, MD (November 14, 2017) – The Board of Directors of the ASHP Research and Education Foundation has selected Steven A. Rubloff as the CEO-designate. Mr. Rubloff will succeed Stephen J. Allen, who will retire at the end of January 2018 after nearly 20 years as CEO of the ASHP Foundation.

An accomplished development professional with extensive leadership experience in the nonprofit sector, Rubloff will be a key member of ASHP’s leadership team. Most recently, Rubloff served as vice president for development at Virginia Hospital Center (VHC) and president of the VHC Foundation, where he led the hospital’s fundraising efforts and oversaw the development and management of the Foundation’s public education and grant award programs.

Previously, Rubloff served as executive director of the American Psychiatric Foundation and director of marketing and development for the American Occupational Therapy Foundation. In all of his prior foundation leadership positions, Rubloff has been instrumental in producing major advances in both program development and fundraising results.

“With a proven track record in the successful operation and transformation of foundations in the healthcare arena, we look forward to the positive impact that Mr. Rubloff will have in support of the Foundation advancing pharmacy practice and improving patient care,” said John (Jack) Tighe III, chair of the ASHP Foundation Board of Directors.

“Mr. Rubloff brings a wealth of relevant experience to the ASHP Foundation,” said ASHP CEO Paul W. Abramowitz. “I am confident that his expertise and leadership will continue to strengthen the Foundation and its work in support of ASHP’s vision that ‘medication use will be optimal, safe, and effective for all people all of the time.’ I greatly look forward to Mr. Rubloff joining us. I also wish to thank Stephen Allen for his 18 years of exceptional service, his partnership, and friendship.”

Rubloff will join the ASHP Foundation in January 2018 and will have the opportunity to transition with Allen prior to his retirement at the end of the month. Rubloff will be based at ASHP’s global headquarters in Bethesda, Maryland.
