

Important Moments in the ASHP Foundation's 50-Year History

- 1968 ASHP Foundation incorporated by Joseph A. Oddis, Milton W. Skolaut, and Joseph K. Beckerman on November 23rd.
- 1969 Kenneth P. Lusher, ASHP member, makes first major gift.
- 1970 IRS rules Foundation is nonprofit, tax-exempt, and public.
Awards Program transfers from ASHP to the Foundation.
- 1971 First Foundation awards are presented.
- 1972 James H. Agee becomes the first public member.
- 1974 George P. Provost is named first Executive Director.
Quarterly journal, *Drugs in Health Care*, is published.
First Foundation CE program, Institute on Research Methods for Hospital Pharmacists, is established.
- 1976 Establishes an endowment fund.
- 1978 Oncology Fellowship Program is established.
Research Grants Program is established.
Foundation Report newsletter is published.
- 1979 Donald E. Francke Memorial Library is established at ASHP headquarters.
- 1980 Pharmacy Nutritional Support Services Fellowship begins.
Infectious Disease Drug Therapy Fellowship is established.
- 1981 Critical Care Pharmacy Fellowship begins.
- 1982 Demonstration Projects Grant Program is established, replacing Research Grants Program.
- 1983 *Foundation News* newsletter is introduced.
Six new fellowships in five specialty areas are established.
- 1984 Warren E. McConnell is appointed second Executive Vice President.
Hospital Pharmacy Administration Research Grants begins.
Harvey A. K. Whitney Lectures is published.

- 1985 Sponsors Conference on Directions for Clinical Practice in Pharmacy (“Hilton Head” conference).
- 1986 Initiates Anticoagulation Clinic Traineeship Program.
- 1987 Charles M. King, Jr. is appointed as third Executive Vice President.
- 1988 Begins support for the ASHP ACCRUE Program.
George P. Provost Editorial Internship Program begins.
Sponsors Conference on Technical Personnel in Pharmacy.
- 1989 New Pharmacy Practice Researchers Grant Program is established.
Publishes *Medication Use in an Imperfect World: Drug Misadventuring as an Issue of Public Policy*, by Henri R. Manasse, Jr. Ph.D.
- 1990 “Evaluation of the Effect of Clinical Pharmacists on Inpatient HealthCare Outcomes” study begins with Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington DC.
- 1991 Sponsors Conference on Quality Assurance for Pharmacy Prepared Sterile Products.
Co-sponsors National Clinical Pharmacy Services Survey.
- 1992 Clinical Pharmacy Dialysis Service Traineeship Program is established.
- 1993 25th Anniversary celebration is held at ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting.
Sponsors Conference on Implementing Pharmaceutical Care, San Antonio, Texas.
- 1994 Sponsors Multidisciplinary Conference on Understanding and Preventing Drug Misadventures.
Establishes grants for state affiliates to hold conferences on implementing pharmaceutical care.
- 1995 Provides \$100,000 grant to ASHP to develop the Residency Learning System.
Establishes the Walter Jones Memorial Student Financial Aid Fund.
- 1996 Establishes the Joseph A. Oddis Endowment and raises more than \$1 million.
Supports a pilot of the Pharmacy Student National Clinical Skills Competition.
- 1997 Stem Cell Transplantation and Asthma Patient Care Traineeship begins.
- 1998 ASHP Foundation website debuts.
Sponsors Pharmacy in Managed Care and 2nd Annenberg Patient Safety Conferences.
- 1999 Pharmacists as Immunization Advocates Program launches.
Joseph A. Oddis Ethics Colloquium is initiated.

- 2000 Stephen J. Allen is appointed the Foundation's fourth Chief Executive Officer. Fail-Safe Medication Management Research Demonstration Project is initiated.
- 2001 Pharmacy Resident Medication Safety Grant Program is established. Medication Safety and Applied Therapeutics Research Grant Programs are initiated. Joseph A. Oddis Endowment exceeds the \$5 million mark.
- 2002 Diabetes Patient Care Traineeship program is established. Co-sponsors invitational conference, "Measuring Medication Safety in Hospitals."
- 2003 Critical Care, Oncology, and Pain Management Traineeships are established. Federal Services Research Grant Program, Optimizing Chronic Drug Therapy in the Elderly, is established. Pharmacy/Nursing Research Grant Program is established.
- 2004 The ASHP Foundation and the Cardinal Health Foundation introduce the Award for Excellence in Medication Safety.
- 2006 The ASHP Foundation launches the Pharmacy Residency Excellence Awards. ASHP and the Foundation create the Center for Health-System Pharmacy Leadership.
- 2008 The ASHP Foundation launches the Pharmacy Leadership Academy. Funds "Medication Errors Recovered by Emergency Department Pharmacists" study. Funds "Medication Continuity of Care Record" project.
- 2009 Launches "Demonstrating the Pharmacist's Value" study.
- 2010 The ASHP Foundation launches the David A. Zilz Leaders for the Future Fund. ASHP and the Foundation establish the Practice Advancement Initiative. ASHP and the Foundation sponsor the Pharmacy Practice Model Initiative Summit. "Demonstrating the Pharmacist's Impact on Outcomes" study is published and gains national news attention.
- 2011 Establishes the Henri R. Manasse Legacy Fund. Launches the Pharmacy Residency Expansion Grants.
- 2013 ASHP Foundation introduces the *Pharmacy Forecast Report* series.
- 2014 ASHP and the Foundation sponsor the Ambulatory Care Summit. Launches the "Drug Therapy Management Complexity Score Index" project.
- 2018 Steven A. Rubloff is selected to be the Foundation's fifth Chief Executive Officer.
