Mission

The **Mission** of the ASHP Foundation is to improve the health and well-being of patients in health systems through appropriate, safe and effective medication use. Program Focus

The **ASHP Foundation Corporate Membership** initiative focuses on shared responsibility for the public health including medication safety, optimal patient medication outcomes, capacity to meet current and future patient care needs, optimal pharmacy practice model development and implementation, and expanded pharmacist leadership with accountability.

Program Timeline

Membership is annual, on a calendar or fiscal year depending on the preference of the participating member. A one-hour informational webinar with our advisory committee members is offered shortly after the June ASHP Summer Meetings. In November we host a day-long meeting at ASHP headquarters in Bethesda. One-on-one meetings with members are scheduled throughout the year.

Major Objectives

1. Advance the direct patient care role of the pharmacist, and
2. Leadership development for pharmacists in all phases of their career development.

- Discuss ways in which healthcare corporations and the ASHP Foundation can partner to ensure that pharmacists expand their direct patient care role to improve medication outcomes.
