Kelly Epplen, PharmD, BCACP, FASHP is an Associate Professor at the James L. Winkle College of Pharmacy, University of Cincinnati, where she also received her Doctor of Pharmacy degree in 1997. Dr. Epplen has had a primary role in the development of ambulatory care pharmacist services at several health-systems in the Greater Cincinnati area with particular focus in antithrombotic management and pharmacotherapy services. She currently provides direct patient care at the Family Practice Center of St. Elizabeth Healthcare and has helped to establish ambulatory care pharmacist services in physician offices settings across Northern Kentucky. She is an advisory board member for the APhA/ASHP Ambulatory Care BPS Examination Review and Recertification Course and has co-authored the business plan development chapter in ASHPs publication: Building a Successful Ambulatory Practice. She authored a Briefing Paper for the ASHP Ambulatory Care Summit entitled "Patient care delivery and integration: Stimulating advancement of ambulatory care pharmacy practice in an era of healthcare reform." In addition, she is a contributing author for ASHPs Minimum Practice Standards for Ambulatory Care Pharmacy Practice and serves as Chair of the ASHP Section of Ambulatory Care Practitioners. Dr. Epplen received her Board Certification in Ambulatory Care in October of 2011.
