Sandra Leal, Pharm.D., M.P.H., is the vice president of Innovation at SinfoniaRx, a national provider of medication therapy management services. Dr. Leal works to establish integrated clinical pharmacy services in a variety of settings, including a hospital discharge program, integrated behavioral health clinics, accountable care organizations and patient-centered medical homes. She utilizes telehealth and other strategies to scale resources to communities, clinicians and patients.

Dr. Leal currently serves as vice chair for the National Center for Farmworker Health and as Mission Delivery chair for the Southern Arizona Diabetes Association. Her programs have received the APhA Foundation Pinnacle Award (twice), the ASHP Best Practice Award in Health-System Pharmacy, and the National Association of Community Health Centers' Innovative Research in Primary Care Award. Her work has been published in *Diabetes Care*, *Advances in Chronic Kidney Disease*, *American Journal for Health-System Pharmacy*, and a discussion paper published by the Institute of Medicine entitled, "Patients and Health Care Teams Forging Effective Partnerships."

Dr. Leal received her doctoral degree from the University of Colorado and her master's degree in public health practice from the University of Massachusetts. She completed a residency at the Southern Arizona VA Health Care System and a primary health care policy fellowship with the Department of Health and Human Services.
