

## Important Moments in the ASHP Foundation's 50-Year History

- 1968 ASHP Foundation incorporated by Joseph A. Oddis, Milton W. Skolaut, and Joseph K. Beckerman on November 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- 1969 Kenneth P. Lush, ASHP member, makes first major gift.
- 1970 IRS ruled Foundation was non-profit tax-exempt and public.  
Awards Program transferred from ASHP to the Foundation.
- 1971 First Foundation awards presented.
- 1972 James H. Agee became the first public member.
- 1974 George P. Provost becomes first Executive Director  
Published quarterly journal, *Drugs in HealthCare*.  
Established 1<sup>st</sup> Foundation CE program, Institute on Research Methods for Hospital Pharmacists
- 1976 Established an endowment fund.
- 1978 Oncology Fellowship Program established.  
Research Grants Program established  
*Foundation Report* newsletter published
- 1979 Donald E. Franke memorial Library established at ASHP headquarters.
- 1980 Pharmacy Nutritional Support Services Fellowship began.  
Infectious Disease Drug Therapy Fellowship established.
- 1981 Critical Care Pharmacy Fellowship began.
- 1982 Demonstration Projects Grant Program, established, replacing Research Grant Programs.
- 1983 *Foundation News* newsletter introduced.  
Six more fellowships in five more specialty areas established.
- 1984 Appointment of Warren E. McConnell as Executive Vice President.  
Hospital Pharmacy Administration Research Grants began.  
Harvey A. K. Whitney lectures published.
- 1985 Conference on Directions for Clinical Practice in Pharmacy ("Hilton Head" conference).

- 1986 Initiated Anticoagulation Clinic Traineeship Program.
- 1987 Charles M. King, Jr. appointed as Executive Vice President.
- 1988 Began support for the ASHP ACCRUE Program.  
George P. Provost Editorial Internship Program began.  
Sponsored Conference on Technical Personnel in Pharmacy.
- 1989 New Pharmacy Practice Researchers Grant Program established.  
Published *Medication Use in an Imperfect World: Drug Misadventuring as an Issue of Publish Police*, by Henri R. Manasse, Jr. Ph.D.
- 1990 "Evaluation of the Effect of Clinical Pharmacists on Inpatient HealthCare Outcomes," study began with Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington DC.
- 1991 Sponsored Conference on Quality Assurance for Pharmacy Prepared Sterile Products.  
Co-sponsored National Clinical Pharmacy Services Survey.
- 1992 Clinical Pharmacy Dialysis Service Traineeship Program established.
- 1993 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration began at ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting.  
Sponsored Conference on Implementing Pharmaceutical Care, San Antonio, TC,  
"Evaluation of the Effect of Clinical Pharmacists on Impatient Healthcare Outcomes."
- 1994 Sponsored Multidisciplinary Conference on Understanding and Preventing Drug Misadventures.  
Established grants to state affiliates to hold conference before implementing pharmaceutical care.
- 1995 \$100K grant provided to ASHP to develop the Residency Learning System.  
Established the Walter Jones Student Memorial Aid fund.
- 1996 Established the Joseph A. Oddis Endowment and raised over \$1 million.  
Supported pilot of the Pharmacy Student National Clinical Skills Competition.
- 1997 Stem Cell Transplantation and Asthma Patient care traineeship began.
- 1998 ASHP Foundation Website debuted.  
Sponsored Pharmacy in Managed Care and 2<sup>nd</sup> Annenberg Patient Safety Conferences.
- 1999 Pharmacists as Immunization Advocates Program launched.  
Joseph A. Oddis Ethics Colloquium initiated.

- 2000 Stephen J. Allen appointed Executive Vice President.  
Fail-Safe Medication Management Research Demonstration project initiated.
- 2001 Pharmacy Resident medication Safety Grant program established.  
Medication Safety and Applied Therapeutics Research Grant Programs initiated.  
Joseph A. Oddis Endowment exceeds the \$5 million mark.
- 2002 Diabetes Patient Care Traineeship program established.  
Co-sponsored invitational conference, Measuring Medication Safety in Hospitals.
- 2003 Critical Care, Oncology, and Pain Management traineeship programs established.  
Federal Services Research Grant Program, Optimizing Chronic Drug Therapy in the Elderly established.  
Pharmacy/Nursing Research Grant Program established.
- 2004 The ASHP Foundation establishes the Award for Excellence in Medication Safety.
- 2006 The ASHP Foundation establishes the Pharmacy Residency Excellence Awards.  
ASHP and the Foundation establish the Center for Health-System Pharmacy Leadership.
- 2008 The ASHP Foundation launches the Pharmacy Leadership Academy.
- 2010 The ASHP Foundation launches the David A. Zilz Leaders for the Future Fund to support the development of new leadership program opportunities for pharmacists.  
ASHP and the Foundation establish the Practice Advancement Initiative.  
ASHP and the Foundation sponsor the PPMI Summit 25 years after the Hilton Head Conference (initiation of the ASHP Pharmacy Practice Model initiative)
- 2013 ASHP Foundation introduces the *Pharmacy Forecast Report* series.
- 2014 ASHP and the Foundation sponsor the Ambulatory Care Summit.
- 2018 Steven A. Rubloff is appointed Chief Executive Officer of the ASHP Foundation.
