ASHP Foundation Recognizes 2016-2017 Critical Care Traineeship Participants

Nine pharmacists completed intensive training to improve care of patients who are critically ill

**BETHESDA, MD** (August 3, 2017) -- Nine pharmacists recently completed the ASHP Research and Education Foundation's Critical Care Concentrated Traineeship.

This ACPE-accredited educational experience aims to train pharmacists to develop and maintain specialized services for the management of critically ill patients. Trainees received both intensive distance and experiential training to prepare them to participate on patient care teams as the health professional responsible and accountable for patients' medication-related outcomes. The distance learning component coupled with 10 contiguous days of experiential training and a variety of post-training activities enabled participants to develop the clinical skills necessary to become the medication expert on interdisciplinary teams to optimize the safety, quality, and care of critically ill patients.

"This training program helps pharmacists hoping to advance their careers develop the necessary skill sets to improve outcomes for critically ill patients," said Stephen J. Allen, M.S., FASHP, ASHP Foundation chief executive officer. "It also gives participants an opportunity to network with experienced critical care pharmacists. The long-term guidance from traineeship preceptors ensures that participants are able to develop critical care pharmacy services at their institutions."
